Admission and registration

Access to OCA libraries is restricted to employees, registered students and visitors of the Observatory (others persons: contact us).

Users must be registered with the library before making use of Library services (loan and e-resources).

Loan policy

Library borrower is responsible for library materials checked out under his/her name, and for returning items in due time.

Loan periods vary for different categories of user:

- Permanent employees and post doctoral fellows: 20 books for 90 days
- Doctoral students: 15 books for 60 days
- Visitors, trainees, temporary members
- a) stay longer than 30 days:
- 3 books for 30 days
- b) stay shorter than 30 days :
- 3 books for 7 days

Journals, reference books and historic collection do not circulate.

The authorization is strictly personal and may not, under any circumstances, be transferred to a third party. Access is governed by licence agreement.
